HEALTH & SAFETY TIPS:

COVID-19, aka **Coronavirus**, is a new respiratory illness. In most people, symptoms include fever, cough, and/or shortness of breath and can be mild or severe. Here is how you can help to protect yourself and others:

- Avoid social contact as much as possible, including hugging, kissing, shaking hands, and sharing food, drinks, and cigarettes.
- Stay about 6 feet away from other people.
- Keep your hands and body clean. If you do not have access to warm water and soap, use hand sanitizer.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth.
- Avoid crowded areas.
- Cover your cough.
